

Six held for giving extortion calls, death threats to MLAs

Haryana Special Task Force Finds Pak, West Asia Connection

Gurgaon: The Special Task Force of the Haryana Police has arrested six people for allegedly giving death threats and extortion calls to MLAs, an officer said on Sunday.

Four MLAs from the state received such calls from June 24 to 28 from multiple phone numbers which were traced to West Asian countries and operated from Pakistan, STF Inspector General of Police (IGP) Satish Kumar told the media at the unit's headquarters in Bawal on Sunday.

Some ex-MLAs from Punjab, too, had received similar threats from these numbers. The callers spoke to them in Mumbai accent and in Punjabi, the IGP said.

The other four - Amit Yadav, Sadiq Anwar, Sanjay Kumar, Kishu Alam - all natives of Bihar, were arrested from the state's Muzaffarpur, he said. Fifty five ATM cards, 24 mobile phones, 66 SIM cards, 22 passbooks and cheque books, Rs 3.97 lakh, an SUV, three diaries and a register were recovered from them, the IGP said.

HRs were lodged against unknown people for issuing death threats to the MLAs af-

ter which Haryana Director General of Police P K Agrawal assigned the case to the STF.

IGP Balan said as part of the STF's strategy to nab the accused, the force disguised itself and deliberately came in the gang's radar after which its personnel too began receiving similar threat calls.

In the garb of paying up the money demanded by the callers, the police teams noted their particulars, such as bank accounts details, following which raids were held across Mumbai and Muzaffarpur simultaneously, Balan said.

During investigation, the STF also learnt about 10 Pakistani residents through whom the threats and extortion calls were made, he added.

The IGP said the culprits often offered Rs 15-20,000 to poor people and lured them into opening bank accounts to carry out the gang's transactions.

"These accused do not belong to any criminal gang or terrorist organisation. This is a gang of very sharp criminals who are involved in professional fraud, money laundering and have their members across Pakistan, Middle East (West Asia) and India," he said.

"People sitting in these other countries would entice victims in the guise of an entry into Kaun Basesa Creepit' or saying they have won lotteries or by extortion calls and would make them transfer the money to the account numbers given by Dulsh or Amil," he said.

I held in Mangaluru youth murder case

Mangaluru: Police officers investigating the murder of Mohammed Fazil combed through registration details of 1,000 cars and questioned more than 100 people in the past 48 hours before making the first arrest in the case late on Saturday. Fazil (25) was hacked to death by a group of people at Surathkal in Mangaluru district of Karnataka on July 31.

The arrested person has been identified as Ajith Crasin, who owned the car hired allegedly by the assailants. Police said the car - a compact, entry-level vehicle - is registered in the name of Ajith's wife. Acting on a tip-off, police tracked down the car near Kadakunja in Inna village near Padubidri in Udipi district, 38km from the scene of the crime, on Sunday.

ADGP (law and order) Alok Mohan told TOI that Ajith is the first to be arrested in the case. Sources said Ajith and one of the accused in the murder case had interacted many times in the past about renting of vehicles.

NIA detains UP Madrasa student for 'terror links'

Saharanpur (UP): A madrasa student, hailing from Karnataka, was detained for questioning by a team of the National Investigation Agency on Sunday for suspected terror links.

The student, Farukh, was staying at a madrasa in Deoband of Saharanpur, police sources said. The student was let off after eight hours of questioning. Senior Superintendent of Police Vinod Tada confirmed Farukh's detention. According to the sources, Farukh is adept in many languages and was allegedly in touch with an operative of the Pakistani intelligence unit ISI via a social media app.

Fazil (25) was a resident of Mangaluru in Karnataka under Surathkal police station jurisdiction. Mangaluru City police suspect the involvement of a crowd of people in his murder. Mangaluru City police commissioner N Shashi Kumar said, "Based on

CCTV footage, we started looking for cars of a similar model, colour and brand (used in the murder). Since there was no clarity on the vehicle's number plate, police made a list of similar cars in that area. In the past two days, they zeroed in on cars in use in the surrounding areas. From the list, the search was narrowed down to about 15 cars. Seven people, including those working in banks, refineries and private companies, were questioned in an attempt to identify the owner."

On Saturday evening, car owner Ajith was taken into custody. During interrogation, he reportedly provided information about those who had hired the car from him. "Based on the inputs provided by the car owner, we'll take steps to arrest the culprits. As the investigation is under progress, we cannot reveal more details," Shashi Kumar said.

Ajith has two cars and a lorry which he gives on rent. One of the accused in the case was in touch with him for a long time. In the past too, he had hired the car from him.

Rail, road traffic hit as farmers stage protests in Punjab & Haryana

Chandigarh: Farmers on Sunday squatted on railway tracks and blocked roads at several places in Punjab and Haryana as part of the Samyukt Kisan Morcha's nationwide protest against the Centre "betraying its promises" made when the agitation against now-repealed farm laws was withdrawn last year.

In Punjab, the Ferozepur division of Indian Railways had to cancel or reschedule several trains because of the four-hour agitation.

As a result, scores of passengers were forced to wait at various railway stations for hours.

According to railway officials, Amritsar Pathankot, Amritsar-Qadian, Pathankot-Verka were among five trains which were cancelled while eight trains, including Amritsar-Jaynagar, Amritsar-Sealdah, Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Katra-New Delhi, Amritsar-New Delhi/Amritsar-Ajmer Express were rescheduled.

Two trains - Bathinda-Fazilka and Fazilka-Bathinda - were short terminated, they said.

"I, along with my wife, came here for treatment. We had to return to Jammu today. Our train, which was scheduled to arrive at 10:30 am, got delayed for several hours," said a Jammu-based man at Jalandhar railway station.

A woman from Jalandha was to go to Jammu to pay obeisance at the Mata Vaishno Devi shrine but her

train also got delayed due to the farmers' agitation.

"We have been waiting for the train for hours," said the woman. Many trains were stopped and roads were blocked at several places from 11 am till 3 pm.

Bharatiya Kisan Union (BKU)-Kadian president Harmeet Singh Kadian, participating in the protest at Phillaur railway station, said the farmers were holding the protest on the call given by the Samyukt Kisan Morcha (SKM), an umbrella body of farmers' unions.

Farmers alleged that they were forced to squat on rail tracks as the Centre was "not listening to their demands".

BKU (Ekta Ugrahna) general secretary Sukhdev Singh Kokrikaian said their members staged dharnas at eight toll plazas in six districts and 10 highways, including Ludhiana-Ferozepur highway at Mullampur and squatted at rail tracks at Bathinda, Budhalda, Malerkotla and Patli.

LeT militant killed in Baramulla

Srinagar: One Lashkare-Taba militant was killed in an encounter with security forces in Baramulla district of J&K on Sunday, police said. The militant was identified as Irshad Ahmad Bhat, a resident of Baramulla's Pattan. The security forces launched a search and search operation in the Binnee area of the district on Saturday evening on the basis of information about the presence of militants there, a police official said. He said the search operation turned into an encounter after the militant opened fire at the security forces, who retaliated. One militant was killed in the exchange of firing, he added. "Killed terrorist has been identified as Irshad Ahmad Bhat of Pattan @Baramulla, active since 5/2022. He linked with proscribed terrorist outfit LeT, 65 AK rifle, 2 magazines & 30 rounds recovered," the Kashmiri Zonal Police tweeted.

7 Guj students caught trying to enter New York via Quebec

Ahmedabad: There are plenty of distressing stories about the risks people take to enter the US illegally but probably not enough to deter Gujarat youths obsessed with making it to American soil. In July, seven students from north Gujarat were caught by US immigration officers while attempting to enter New York through the Quebec route, officers of Gujarat Police told TOI. Aged between 20 and 25, the men from Gandhinagar and Mehsana had gone to Canada in the second week of July, hoping to cross over into the US.

"They were arrested while entering New York via Quebec in Canada by the US Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE), face charges under the Alien Act and are under detention in Albany," said a source. Gujarat Police tried to gather details about the seven by questioning their families, but to no avail. The kin of those detained maintained that they

were unaware of the journey of the seven in the US. Police sources said the seven men procured forged IELTS certificates with the help of a local agent from Mehsana and his counterpart in Delhi and travelled to Canada on student visas. "When they attempted to cross over into the US, they were caught by the US agency," said a police source.

On May 5, six from Gujarat - most of them from Mehsana - were rescued after their boat began sinking in the St Regis River along the Canada-US border. A local court later exempted them from criminal proceedings and asked them to advise their countrymen to not enter the US illegally. A thriving human smuggling network came to the fore when a family of four from Dinguacha was found frozen to death near the Canada-US border on January 16. Jagdish Patel (38), his wife Vaishali (37), and their children Vihangi (12) and Dharmik (6), lost their lives while embarking on a perilous journey to the US.

Around 34L income tax returns filed till 4pm on last day

New Delhi: Nearly 34 lakh income tax returns were filed till 4 pm on the last day of filing ITR for 2021-22 fiscaly by salaried individuals, the IT department said on Sunday. The deadline for filing ITR returns, by those taxpayers who do not have to get their accounts audited for the fiscal ended on March 31, 2022, is Sunday.

Till July 30, more than 5.10 crore tax returns had been filed. Giving statistics of Income Tax Returns (ITR) filed on Sunday, the IT department tweeted: "33,73,975 ITRs have been filed up to 1600 hours today & 4,73,228 ITRs filed in the last hr." The IT department also asked taxpayers to seek assistance regarding ITR filing by emailing to form@gov.in or calling help desk numbers 1800 303 0025 and 1800 419 0025. According to tax laws, a Rs 5,000 late fee would be payable by people having an annual income of over Rs 5 lakh, if they file their ITR by December 31 of the assessment year.
