This agreement entered into on the **05th January** day of the year **2023** at **3:00 PM**

BETWEEN

M/s Bio-Genetic Laboratories Pvt. Ltd hereinafter called as Service Provider (SP) with its Registered Office at LG-23, Urnila Tower, Bank More, Dhanbad represented by Sitajit Pandey Market Executive.

AND

ESI Steel Limited, Sijarjori Chandankiyari, Bokaro
(Hereinafter referred to as the GENERATOR) represented by **Mr. Venkatesan Rajamanickam**
Whereas SP has setup a common facility at Chhota Pichhri, Kalyanpur, Dhanbad for collection, reception, storage, transportation, treatment and disposal of Bio-Medical Wastes (hereinafter called as BMW) generated by the Health Care Establishment (HCE)

Whereas SP offers to provide services to the GENERATOR on a User Pay principle for collection, transportation, treatment and disposal of BMW for beds as under:

Whereas SP undertakes the liability of collection, transportation, treatment and disposal of BMW, the GENERATOR shall undertake to adhere to this contract of service by SP for a minimum period of 1 year or till the authorization from JSPCB in favour of BGL exist, from the agreement date. The rate will be revised whenever the rate is revised by JSPCB. at the time renewal no registration fee will be charge

Whereas the GENERATOR is a Hospital and agrees to avail the services being provided by SP with the terms and conditions as listed on succeeding paras;

RESPONSIBILITIES OF SP

- 1.SP shall meet all the rules and regulations stipulated by the Jharkhand State Pollution control Board, Ranchi and the GENERATOR shall not be liable for improper handling and management of BMW. The responsibility of SP begins only after the properly segregated BMW by the GENERATOR is collected by SP.
- 2.SP alone is liable for violation of the Environment (Protection) Act 1986 and the relevant rules made there under, after collection of BMW from the GENERATOR unit as per the agreement terms and conditions.
- 3.SP shall collect BMW from the hospital within 48 hrs. In case of failure to collect the BMW from the designated time (48 hours), the SP shall be informed by the GENERATOR in writings that action may be taken by the SP to collect BMW.
- 4.SP shall collect the segregated bio-medical waste from the identified common waste collection site in the hospital.
- 5.SP shall transport the segregated waste in closed container vehicle to the treatment plant.
- 6.The initial training about segregation of BMW in colour plastic bags and methods of collection of BMW by SP shall be provided by SP, at no extra cost. The GENERATOR will have to depute their authorized personnel to SP training centre.
- 7.SP shall schedule the field visits for collecting the waste in consultation with the hospital which would be notified in advance. Any change in schedule has to be agreed mutually.
- 8.SP shall attend try to all the genuine complaints with in the shortest time possible.
- 9.SP promises to keep high standard of pollution control and shall update its equipment/facility as and when required.

- 10.SP will not be liable for Environment (Protection) Act 1986 or any similar regulations/norm set up by Jharkhand Pollution control Board, government Bodies, in the event the GENERATOR violates any of the terms and conditions of this agreement.
- 11.SP shall be responsible for appropriate treatment and shredding of disinfected waste at the centralized facility as per Schedule-1 of the BMW (M&H) rules, 1998.
- 12.SP shall also undertake testing of treated waste to ensure safety to the environment.
- 13.SP shall be responsible for the disposal of treated waste into secured landfills or in recycling plants.
- 14.SP will provide the plastic bags as stipulated by the Ministry of Environment and forest vide notification dated 20.07.1998, Procurement of BAR Coded bags and Containers may be purchased from SP. BMW shall not be lifted if not provided by SP and without BAR Code.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1.The Occupier shall pay the monthly charges of cost of disposal after completion of the month by 5th of every next month without fail.
- 2. If the occupier fails to pay the monthly service charges or makes less than the amount for two consecutive months the services will be stopped without giving any notice and the agreement would become inoperable with immediate effect.
- 3.All the payments shall be made in favour of SP in the form of DD or A/c favouring Bio-Genetic Laboratories Pvt Ltd, Current in A/c No- 0015020000240, Bank of Baroda, Dhanbad (IFSC Code- BARB0DHANBA) Payee cheques. All bounced cheques shall be charged at Rs.200/- extra in addition to the actual bank charges. The mandatory provisions of income tax for deducting tax at source shall apply.
- 4. If the GENERATOR violates any clause of Quotation /Agreement or willingly discontinues to avail the services from SP or defaults in timely payment against services rendered by SP, his membership will deem to have been cancelled and the agreement would become inoperable with immediate effect.
- 5. Once the agreement is cancelled for reasons as mentioned in para 4.0 above and the GENERATOR wants to resume the services of BMW collection and disposal then a fresh agreement has to be entered after payment of applicable Membership Fee.
- 6.SP shall indemnify all costs, expenses, damages etc. in relation to handling /mishandling /omission to handle the bio-medical waste
- 7.SP's failure to collect the bio-medical waste as per provisions of Bio-medical Waste Management and handling rules 1998 even after expiry of 48 hours. The SP shall be informed by the GENERATOR in writings that action may be taken by the SP to collect BMW.
- 8.All disputes, differences, claims etc. arising from or out of the agreement shall be subject to the exclusive arbitration of the Member Secretary, JSPCB Ranchi.
